2001 Lavacave Symposium part of BRASIL 2001

Recently, 29 April 2000, I was informed by the organizers of BRASIL 2001 (the UIS Congress) (Mr. José Ayrton Labegalini) that during their last meeting it was accepted that the Lavacave Symposium proposed by the Azores would join BRASIL 2001.

Some notes about what happened before:
During the UIS Commission Meeting at the Symposium at Catania (Sept. 1999) it was suggested not to have a symposium at the same year as the UIS Congress. A request was sent to the Azores to reconsider. This was duly reported to the Secretary General of UIS, who reported 'no problem to organize a symposium in 2001.....
expect that Europeans will not be very common in Brazil....'. After some information exchange a letter came the Azores would skip the symposium to 2005 (also a UIS Congres date...) and Iceland went ahead for a symposium in 2002.

I myself am (still) planning to go to Brasil in 2001, where (of course) a Volcanic Caves Commission meeting will be held. So much for now.



But looking at countries as Kenya - 6 references, all by members of our commission.


Hawaii has 12 references.


